Thanks to the efforts of its Advisory Council, the Department of German Studies is able to nominate five students to participate in a new internship program in the state of Baden-Württemberg, Germany for summer 2010. Coordinated by the American Chamber of Commerce in Germany and the international law firm of Bridgehouse Law, internships will begin in late May 2010 and last three months. There will be some remuneration for your participation in the program, but because of the newness of the program it is too early to say how extensive it will be. The application consists of two parts:

1. The form below that will be used by the department to select the five students who will be nominated for the program.
2. The "Student Questionnaire." If you are selected as one of the five students, this form will be used for matching you with a company or organization that corresponds to your areas of interest.

Students will be nominated based on (1) academic merit, (2) their statement of purpose, (3) their reference, and (4) their commitment to the German program at Emory (German majors and minors will receive preference).

The **application deadline** is **November 16, 2009**. Recipients will be notified by December 15, 2009.
